



Fish Along 2023: Siletz River



Join Us at Moonshine County Park on the Siletz River - Sept 22-24

We are planning our annual fishing trip to the Siletz River and want to invite you along. There are plenty of fish in the river including resident trout, sea-run cutthroat and summer steelhead. Most of the water we fish is accessed via a gravel logging road. Logging operations are active and the road is only open on the weekend (Local knowledge: As a courtesy, logging wraps up and road opens a little early on Friday).



We'll be staying in the Moonshine County Park Campground. This is a great county park with flush toilets and showers. Reservations are not available for camp sites. More information: <https://www.co.lincoln.or.us/1060/Moonshine-Park>. There is a market in Logsden (about 10 minutes from the campground) if you forget anything.
